Detail: The Taizé Community is an ecumenical monastic order in Taizé, France. By its very existence, the community is a "parable of community" that wants its life to be a sign of reconciliation between divided Christians and between separated peoples. The community has become one of the world's most important sites of Christian pilgrimage. Over 100,000 young people from around the world make pilgrimages to Taizé each year for prayer, Bible study, sharing, and communal work. Through the community's ecumenical outlook, they are encouraged to live in the spirit of kindness, simplicity and reconciliation.

Meditative singing is one of the most essential elements of worship in Taizé. Short songs, repeating again and again, give it a meditative character.
