

Come & Go Icon Workshops

Our Come and Go Icon Workshops are held in the fall and winter of each year and follows the Byzantine tradition of writing Icons. Participants learn the basic steps and techniques of traditional icon writing in a prayerful and sacred environment, along with guided instruction and theological reflection. After the first session, commit as you are able to attend these evenings of prayer, icon writing and sharing. Anyone interested in writing icons are invited. Please note that materials and pigments are included.

Anna Mycyk has been involved and interested in Iconography since early childhood. After graduating from and teaching at the Ontario College of Art, she worked in graphic design. Over the years, her interest in iconography deepened through related travels abroad and independent studies. Throughout the past 15 years, Anna has participated in traditional Byzantine egg tempera iconography classes and has now established her own studio. The last several years have included teaching the theory and practice of writing icons at the Come and Go Icon Workshop in Saskatoon.
