Type **Three** is adaptable, excelling, driven, and image-conscious.

Type **Four** is expressive, dramatic, self-absorbed, and temperamental.

Type **Five** is perceptive, innovative, secretive, and isolated.

Type **Six** is engaging, responsible, anxious, and suspicious.

Type **Seven** is spontaneous, versatile, acquisitive, and scattered.

Type **Eight** is self-confident, decisive, willful, and confrontational.

Type **Nine** is receptive, reassuring, complacent, and resigned.
