This workshop will focus on the relationship of spirituality and psychology to sexuality and intimacy within a Christian perspective. It will draw extensively on the work of psychologist David Schnarch, Constructing the Sexual Crucible, the writing of Fr. Ron Rolheiser and other theologians, and research on the effect of the brain on sex, sexuality and intimacy.
