Queen's House invites you to participate in the Oblate charism of hospitality. Two volunteer positions are available for you to consider:

LIVE-IN VOLUNTEERS

Live-in volunteers are individuals and/or couples who stay at Queen's House over a weekend and assist with hospitality, security and welcome by being present and available to guests for certain periods of time each day. Duties typically involve welcoming guests and orienting them to the House, ensuring the facility is secure at the end of the day, managing payments for programs, and being available to assist anyone in need. You would be provided with a bedroom, meals, and access to the retreat centre and grounds during off-duty hours. On-thejob training and support is provided.

RECEPTION VOLUNTEERS

This core of volunteers provides a welcoming presence to all those who come to Queen's House. Working with our live-in staff, Reception Volunteers work at the front office reception desk. Duties include warmly greeting people when they arrive at Queen's House, answering the telephone and taking messages, orient our visitors to Queen's House by giving directions to meeting rooms, washrooms, the dining area, chapel, and the grounds. On-the-job training is provided.
