Detail: As disciples and followers of Christ, an important and ongoing aspect of our spiritual journey is the action of discernment. In this workshop we will reflect on how silence, listening, attentiveness and trust all help in discernment, opening us to the voice of the Spirit. We have the example of Jesus, who took time to listen to the voice of the Spirit, to be fed and led by the Spirit's wisdom through prayer, solitude and silence. We become better disciples and better companions to others by listening to the Spirit speaking in our minds, our hearts and our spirit. At the same time we pray for the grace that this prayerful listening will have a transforming effect in our very being, and in our lives.

Presenter: Bishop Emeritus Gerry Wiesner, OMI was ordained in 1963. His ministry has included seminary formation, lay formation, parish missions, retreats, teaching, and leadership. While serving Prince George as bishop he was on several commissions and the executive of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. He taught theology at Newman College (Edmonton) and helped initiate the Lay Formation program in the Diocese of Saskatoon and again in the Prince George diocese. He is a team member of the Spiritual Direction Formation Program at Queen's House.
