**Spiritual Direction** is the process of accompanying someone on their spiritual journey.

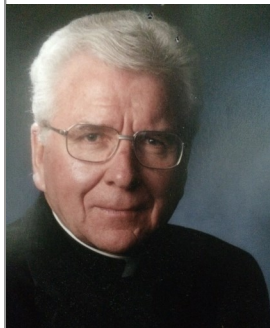
