In in midst of all of this, Julian stressed the goodness of God, life, and nature. "All shall be well." She taught that Divinity was found in Nature. Earlier, St. Thomas Aquinas said, "we have two books of Revelation, Nature and Scripture." How we need to hear this today as we face the climate crisis.

Julian speaks of the Fatherhood and Motherhood of God and urges us to return to the Divine Feminine and gender balance in heart and society, along with non-dualism that is badly needed today. She offers us wisdom to be our deepest self who is one-ing with God.
