Queen's House Affiliates who offer Supervision:

As a supervisor, **Linda Labelle** provides a *confidential contemplative sanctuary* for spiritual directors who desire to foster the spiritual well-being of the absent other – the directee. You will be invited into silence and to a depth beyond the social. This will be a time to savour, ponder, reflect, and unpack the experience of God you had *with* your directee. You will be asked to respond to what you noticed in your direction session, like, where did you see glimpses of the gifts, fruits, or movement of the Holy Spirit. What were signs of life, freedom, joy, compassion, justice, enhanced self-identity before God, truth, invitation, consolation, etc. The experience of supervision is profoundly contemplative. Another focus central to supervision is the deep spiritual identity of the director and who s/he is in God – together we will behold the unique image of God at the core of the director. Supervision engages in Holy Mystery.

Linda, holds a BA (Laurentian University 2002); MA in Ministry and Spirituality; and a Diploma in Spiritual Direction (University of Toronto, Regis College 2004-07). In the Fall of 2010, she later took *Supervision in Spiritual Direction Ministry: Theory and Practice* at Regis College/Toronto School of Theology. It was a full year, one credit, supervision course taught by Maureen McDonnell, D.Min.
