## Segment 4: Our Song of Hope

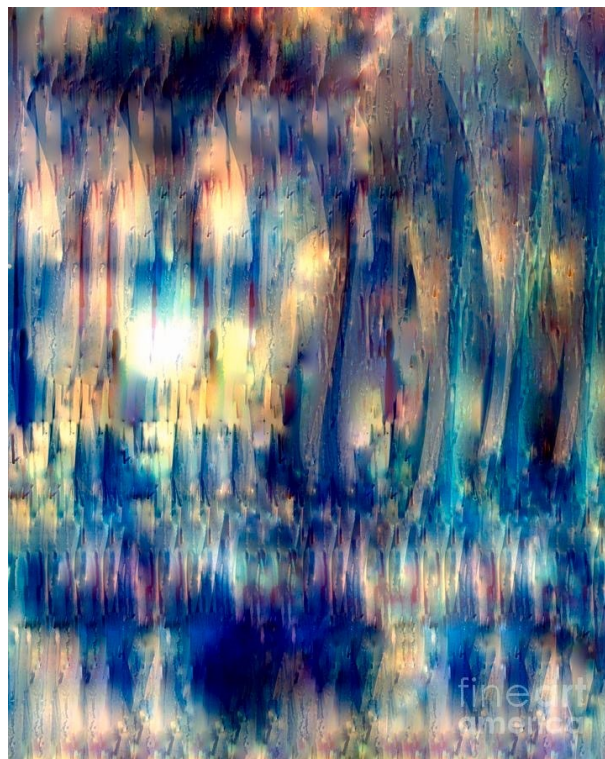
...Christ will come again
